Fabric suggestions:

Bright blue fabric for sky
Light yellow printed fabric for house
Darker yellow fabric for rims
Coordinating fabric for roof
Black fabric for holes
Wood fabric for bases, posts and tree
Bright green fabric for leaves
Red fabric for apple
Purple fabric for birds
Yellow fabric for beaks



Other items :

Fusible webbing
Embroidery floss
Template material



Designer's Notes:

No seam allowances are included with templates, so please add your usual 1/8-1/4 inch all around if you wish to use needle turn appliqué. Templates for tree, leaves, apples and birds will need to be reversed. I used light fusible webbing for all pieces. I used a mottled purple fabric for my "purple martins", but as usual, please use any fabrics of your choice.

Instructions:

1. Cut a 13 inch square piece of sky fabric, which will be

trimmed to 12.5-inch measurement when block is complete.

2. Position house on background, then tuck two bottom bases as shown. Next tuck in birdie posts as shown.
3. Add the three rims, holes and roof.
4. Next add tree, leaves and apple.
5. Add birds, one to post and one flying above. Tuck beaks underneath.
6. Stitch block as usual, and you're finished!

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
