

Let It Snow, Man!

October Block by Lois H a/k/a Losi53

Fabric suggestions:

Background - sky 13" x 9 1/2"
grass 13" x 6"
sidewalk 13" x 3"

Rock fabric for wall 8" x 6"

Black for tree, house, spider & cat

White for snowman

Orange for moon, pumpkins & costume

Yellow for house windows

Extra sidewalk fabric for pathway

Green scraps for frog and costume hat

Other items :

Fusible web

Black pigma pen

Black embroidery floss



Designer's Notes:

The pumpkins that are against the wall were cut from an all over pumpkin fabric. They were then fused in front of the wall. I have included small pumpkin shapes in the templates, if you don't have any pumpkin fabric. The spider was made from black scraps left over from cutting out the haunted tree, then fused onto the block. From one of the larger pieces or a small black scrap cut an oval shape for the body of the spider. Bats were drawn on the moon and Trick or Treat was written on the bag with a black pigma pen. The bag handle was made by braiding 3 strands of black embroidery floss and then attaching when fusing the arm and the bag down.

Instructions:

1. Assemble background using the detailed instructions on the templates page.

2. Position house putting windows behind house before fusing.
3. Add moon, tree, pathway and gravestones.
4. Add rock wall. Left side measure 7 1/2" by 1 1/2". Right side measures 3 3/4" by 1 1/2".
5. Add spider, cat, pumpkins and snowman adding bag handle before fusing (see designer's notes).
6. Using pigma pen add writing, bats and faces to pumpkins if needed.
