

# Let It Snow, Man!

## December Block by Tammy a/k/a tammy\_pa

### Fabric suggestions:

Background (13" square)

White print for snowman and drift

Black for hat

Multicolor print for scarf

Orange for nose

Red for cheeks

Green for tree

Brown for tree trunk



### Other items :

Template material

Fusible webbing if desired

Embroidery floss

Pigma pen

### Designer's Notes:

I used green for something different for the background. You can make your templates by drawing on freezer paper, fusible, etc., then cut. For fusible, I cut out the pieces a little larger and trim down to pattern piece after ironed on material. You might want to cut down on the tree branches if you are needle turning.

### Instructions:

1. Cut 13" background piece.
2. Fuse down as follows. Body , head, and scarf. Overlap scarf over head and body. Arms were add making sure right arm is twisted around tree trunk. Then add tree to top.
3. Add snow drift over top of bottom of snowman, but place tree trunk on top of the drift.
4. Add hat and hat band, facing pieces to make sure to flop them

so he's looking in the right direction.

5. Blanket stitch around all parts with matching thread.
6. Embroider the mouth and use pigma pen for eyes.
7. Trim block to 12 1/2 inches
