

# Let It Snow, Man!

## March Block by Joanne a/k/a MungeeTwo

### Fabric suggestions:

Fabric for sky/background (13" square)

White for snowman, penguin & hat

Green for hat and shamrocks

Black for penguin and pot of gold

Contrast for penguin's and snowman's hat

Yellow for beak and feet of penguin

Gold for hatband and gold in pot

Small piece of orange for carrot nose

Small piece for the eyes

**Other items : (see designer's notes)**

Template material: freezer paper, template plastic

Fusible webbing if desired

Seam sealant for needleturn appliqué

Small baby buttons for eyes (optional)




### Designer's Notes:

Templates may be made for this block from freezer paper or template plastic or cereal boxes, for that matter. No seam allowance is included. 1/4" may be added for a turned under hem or a needle turn appliqué. I used Wonder Under Fusible web. Then hand stitched my design down. Decorative blanket stitching or machine stitching will be needed on those raw edges.

### Instructions:

1. Cut a 13" square of sky/background fabric.
2. Cut the snowman and penguin body pieces from the white fabric, adding 1/4" along the edges if you wish to turn under. Clip the curves and use a tiny drop of seam sealant if you are going to appliqué. (You can put some on a square of cardboard and use a toothpick to apply it.)
3. Cut out the two sections of the yellow for the beak and the feet of the penguin, adding 1/4" if needed. Apply these sections to the block. Place in position. But do not adhere until you have the black cut out and ready to go so you can be sure of just where you want them to be placed
4. Cut out the black penguin piece, and the pot of gold, adding 1/4" if needed. Clip curves where needed if turning under the hem. Sew or fuse the penguin piece to the top of the white body. (It may help to mark the wings portion on the white body part.
5. Cut out the contrast for the penguin's hat, and the snowman's hat. After you have positioned the white for the body, the yellow, the black then position the white for the hat and the contrast for the hat. Be sure that the white on the hat goes over the contrast. So it looks like the fur on a hat.
6. Cut out the green hat, and shamrock pieces. After you have your snowman body and arm stitched/fused down (do not fuse/stitch down the arm until you have the shamrocks in place.) place the hat in place. Making sure that the gold is stitched in place last.
7. Cut out the contrast for the eyes, nose, gold for the pot of gold and the hat band.
8. Once everything is fused/stitched in place do a straight stitch line for the snowman's mouth and in between the penguin's toes.

**Any portion of this block may be altered.**
