Playing in the Rain!

Here in Southern California Frosty likes to play in the rain.
No, no it wont make him melt remember he is a special
Snowman, he's magic.
He can do anything! The puddle he is playing in is rain water.

Fabric suggestions:

Background

A rainy sky - 13" x 6 1/4"

grass - 13" x 4 1/2"

blue for puddle

brown for tree

Greens for the tree

Snowman

White on white

Orange for nose

Scraps of your choice for hat, raincoat & umbrella

Other items : (see designer's notes)

Fusible web

*assorted Fabric Markers

*assorted Embroidery Floss

*use what works best for you



Designer's Notes:

Add 1/4" seam allowance to all templates for hand appliqué'.

Reverse all templates for use with fusible web. I used lite fusible web, it's easier to sew through.

Tracing the design onto the paper side of the web. **If you use Ultra hold you cannot sew thought it by hand or machine it will gum up your needles. I embroidered the handle of the umbrella and around anything I wanted to give definition. This will be your choice to do this. Remember to have fun with your block, add anything you wish. I am not much of a writer -- I am a doer, so I hope this works for you.

Instructions:

1. Assemble background.
2. Position the tree, umbrella, and puddle (or anything else you want to add to the background) and secure in place.
3. Add Frosty. You can layer him, or use the whole body piece. Play with it and see which works best for you.

4. Add his hat and raincoat.
5. Secure fused fabric edges.
5. Using markers or embroider floss for face and umbrella handle.

Remember, this is your block. Make whatever changes you want.

Maybe Frosty could be holding his umbrella, or add a friend for him to play with.
