

Let It Snow, Man!

May Bonus Block by Bea a/k/a Holee

Fabric suggestions:

Sky - 13" x 9

Ground - 13" x 4 1/2

Flower garden- 13 x 3 1/2



Other items : (see designer's notes)

Fusible web

*assorted Fabric Markers

*assorted Embroidery Floss

*use what works best for you

*buttons for the apron or eyes or even carrot buttons.

Designer's Notes:

Add 1/4" seam allowance to all templates for hand appliqué'.

Reverse all templates for use with fusible web. I used lite fusible web, it's easier to sew through. Tracing the design onto the paper side of the web.

Instructions:

1. Assemble background. When cutting background pieces, cut the top edge of the garden wavy. Sew the garden in between the sky and ground, leaving a portion on the left side unsewn for the rabbit placement in step 2.

2. The rabbit can be made as one head & body (just tape the head to the body to trace) or you can use 2 different fabric's to make his face stand out more. You need to make a choice now as to how you will do his mouth. You can cut the mouth out and slip a piece of pink fabric under the hole or you can embroider teeth in the mouth or just embroider a mouth. Position the right ear just under the fabric and the left ear sits on top of the fabric face. Use a small piece of pink for the insides of his ears. Position the rabbit behind

the garden & fuse him down, now sew the garden flowers down.

3. Fuse the snowman's apron, rake, arm & hat to him, then fuse him to the block so it looks like he is raking the garden.

4. Add the carrot sign and the sun. You could also add a bird house, tree, birds flying in the sky, etc.

5. Use markers or embroidery floss for faces. Don't forget to give the rabbit whiskers! Put carrots in the garden with fabric or embroider them.

Remember, this is your block. Make whatever changes you want.
