

A Walk In The Woods December Block by Tammy W. a/k/a tammy_pa

Finished Size 16" x 10"

Fabric suggestions:

2 sets of the following:

Scraps of green

Sky blue

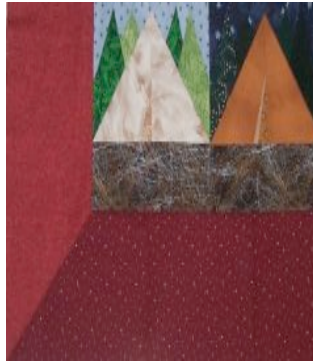
Tent (10" square)

2 pieces to coordinate with
tent

Ground (7" x 3")

Side strip (5" x 11")

Bottom strip (5 x 17")



Designer's Notes:

The block finishes at 6 1/2", so check pattern when copied. To make the block to fit size needed, I added mitered corners. This can be done either with the traditional y-seam like attic window, or it can be done with a half square triangle block and two strips so you don't have to make a y-seam. I made one of my tents more like day and one like night with darker material.

Instructions:

1. Make two copies of the paper piecing tent pattern from <http://www.blockcentral.com/gonecampinpp.pdf>.
2. Paper piece each tent block with you usual paper piecing method. The should measure 6 1/2" with seam allowance.
3. Sew the two blocks together. The block now measures 6 1/2 x

12 1/2.

4. Add strips to make block to 16 1/2" x 10 1/2" (side - 4 1/2 by 10 7/8 and bottom 4 1/2 by 16 7/8. (see Designer's Notes)

Y-seam instructions:

Sew strips on, stopping 1/4" short of joining corner. Fold strips back onto each other to make the 45 degree angle. Take ruler and follow the angle down the edge of the block, drawing a line on the strips. This is the sewing line. Sew on line and press before trimming. You can make the strips bigger for trimming at the end so you have the extra to work with.
