

A Walk In The Woods

March Block by Theresa C a/k/a TeaSea

Finished Size 12" x 12"

Fabric suggestions:

Background: Sky 13" x 10 1/2"
Grass or Snow 13" x 3 1/2"

House & Roof 2 shades of brown

Windows, Door & Chimney Scraps

Other items: Fusible webbing or other adhesive, fabric markers, embroidery floss or yarn



Templates

Designer's Notes:

Reverse all templates for use with fusible web. Add 1/4" seam allowance to all templates for hand appliqué. I used the 'donut' method with the fusible web -- tracing the design onto the paper side of the web then drawing another line 1/4" inside that traced line and cutting away the inner portion of the web. This eliminates much of the stiffness when fusing. It takes a little care when pressing down the web to keep everything smooth, especially with the larger pieces. I used machine blanket stitch, matching the thread color to the fabric, to secure the edges after I fused everything in place. I'm looking for a lost earring for the door handle.

Instructions:

Step 1 – Assemble background by sewing the 10 1/2 and 3 1/2 sides of fabrics together.

Step 2 – Fuse prepared cabin shapes onto background.

Step 3 – Blanket stitch to secure fused fabric edges.

Step 4 – Add any extra you want.

I designed this block for those who wanted a basic block. I wanted to try something new and saw a block on "Simply Quilts" that I just had to try. I hope you try it too..
