

**A Walk In The Woods**

**Designer's Notes:**

I used a green batik to give a leafy forest feeling. I used Heat n Bond to apply appliqués, cutting out the center to avoid stiffness. Bears are 3-dimensional. I used "fun" fabrics - white terrycloth, black velvet and brown flannel. I used black embroidery floss for the brown and white bears. For the black bear, I used DMC320 for the eyes and DMC 300 for the nose and mouth.

**Instructions:**

1. Cut water and trees using template pattern and cut the smaller trees from fabric scraps left from the template trees.
2. Layout as desired. Fuse and stitch to finish edges.

**Bear Heads** (make your own pattern)

1. Make 2 sides for each head and embroider face
2. Cut 2 pieces for ears. Sew right sides together with a 1/8 inch seam and turn out.
3. Pin face right sides together, sticking ears inside and aligning edges with face pieces and stitch all the way around.
4. Cut a slit in back of the head to turn.
5. Stitch onto block with unobtrusive machine stitches near mouth and eyes.
