

A Walk In The Woods
July Block by Nancy S. a/k/a NancyBG

Finished Size 12" x 8"

Fabric

suggestions:

Background: Blue/Green -12 1/2 x 8 1/2

Stream River rock - 12 1/2 x 3 1/2

Bottom:

Fish: Various coordinating colors
White for eye

Reeds: Green scraps

Other items: Coordinating thread, fusible webbing, black paint, embroidery floss or permanent pen

Designer's Notes:

Pattern pieces are actual size. Add 1/4" seam allowance if doing needle turn appliqué. The dotted lines go under the adjoining piece. The reeds in the water are just slivers of various greens cut with a rotary cutter. I used machine blanket stitch with transparent thread after fusing everything in place.

Instructions:

1. Cut pattern pieces out of fabric and position pieces as desired.
2. Cut fish eye socket out of fish and slide small patch of white between fish and background.
3. Fuse pieces in place.
4. Blanket stitch or needle turn to secure fabric edges.
5. Finish fish eye with your choice of paint, permanent pen or embroidery floss.

You can also omit the river rocks and just use an all water background, or you could use a light brown to resemble a mud creek bottom, if you prefer.

**You might want to dangle a fish hook in front of his face.
