

A WARM CABIN GETAWAY  
January Block by Rosemary [rastrube@cox.net](mailto:rastrube@cox.net)

10 ½" block will finish to a 10" block

Fabric suggestion:

Blue fabric for sky

Green or White (snow) for ground

Brown for cabin

Brown/Gray for roof

Yellow/Gold for windows

Red brick for chimney

Various gray/brown for walkway

White for snow

Other items:

Tree applique (I cut mine from Wal Mart

Glue stick

Fusible web or Tearaway Stabilizer

Notes:

No seam allowances are included with the patterns. Add 1/4" if you do needle turn applique. I did machine applique and used a lightweight tear away stabilizer on the back.

Please feel free to copy the design as it's shown or just make any changes you wish. My applique on the right side also had deer which I included. You could add birds, a snowman, anything you wish.

Just try to have fun and run away with it - you will be surprised how creative these blocks can become with your personal touches. I think it would be nice to make it a memory quilt and try to include things you might have done as a child.

In case you don't like to do the fussy cut applique I'm including a pattern for a couple of trees you can add to the design.

Most of all, I hope you just have fun like I did! Enjoy!

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Sky: Cut 4" x 11" from blue fabric

Ground: Cut piece 7" x 11" from your ground fabric of choice

Stitch together with 1/4" seam allowance.

Trees next behind the cabin if desired

Next is the chimney and then the cabin which is 1 piece, then add the back left roof piece covered by the large front roof

Add the door and windows and the pathway.

More trees on the front left and then snow on the ground

NOW:

Add your own fun touches - maybe some smoke out of the chimney a snowman, a stack of wood for the fire, just enjoy!
