March Block 2008

Use a foundation square cut 10 1/2 to 11" inches muslin or sky fabric. No seam allowances are included with the patterns. Add 1/4 if you do needle turn appliqué. Machine appliqué right on the foundation square.

You will work from the top down to the bottom on this block.

Have fun and enjoy making the block. I had a lot of fun doing this block!!

Fabric suggestion:

Blue Fabric for sky

White for snow.

Purples, browns, gray for Mountains

Gray or white for the roof of the cabin

Blue for the river

Greens for the trees

White and tan for the Aspen Trees

Brown for the deer

Cabin fabric..your choice

Other items:

Fabric that has designs in for fussy cutting

Glue stick

Fusible web

SKY....if you are using muslin for the foundationcut a strip 3 ½ x 10 ½". Place this at the top of the fabric

MOUNTAINS...Use 2 differ pieces of fabric for the mountains. #1 Mountain is the farrest away. You will overlap #2 over it. You can appliqué the tops of the mountains. At this time you can add the SNOW CAPS if you wish.

LAND/SNOW.... Your fabric can be the same or pick a differ one for each part. #3 land will be on the same side as #1 Mtn. #4 will overlap #3.

Please DO NOT SEW IN PLACE.

CABIN...Place the cabin of you choice between the two pieces of land. Land 4 will overlap some of the cabin. Make the ROOF of you cabin, white for snow.

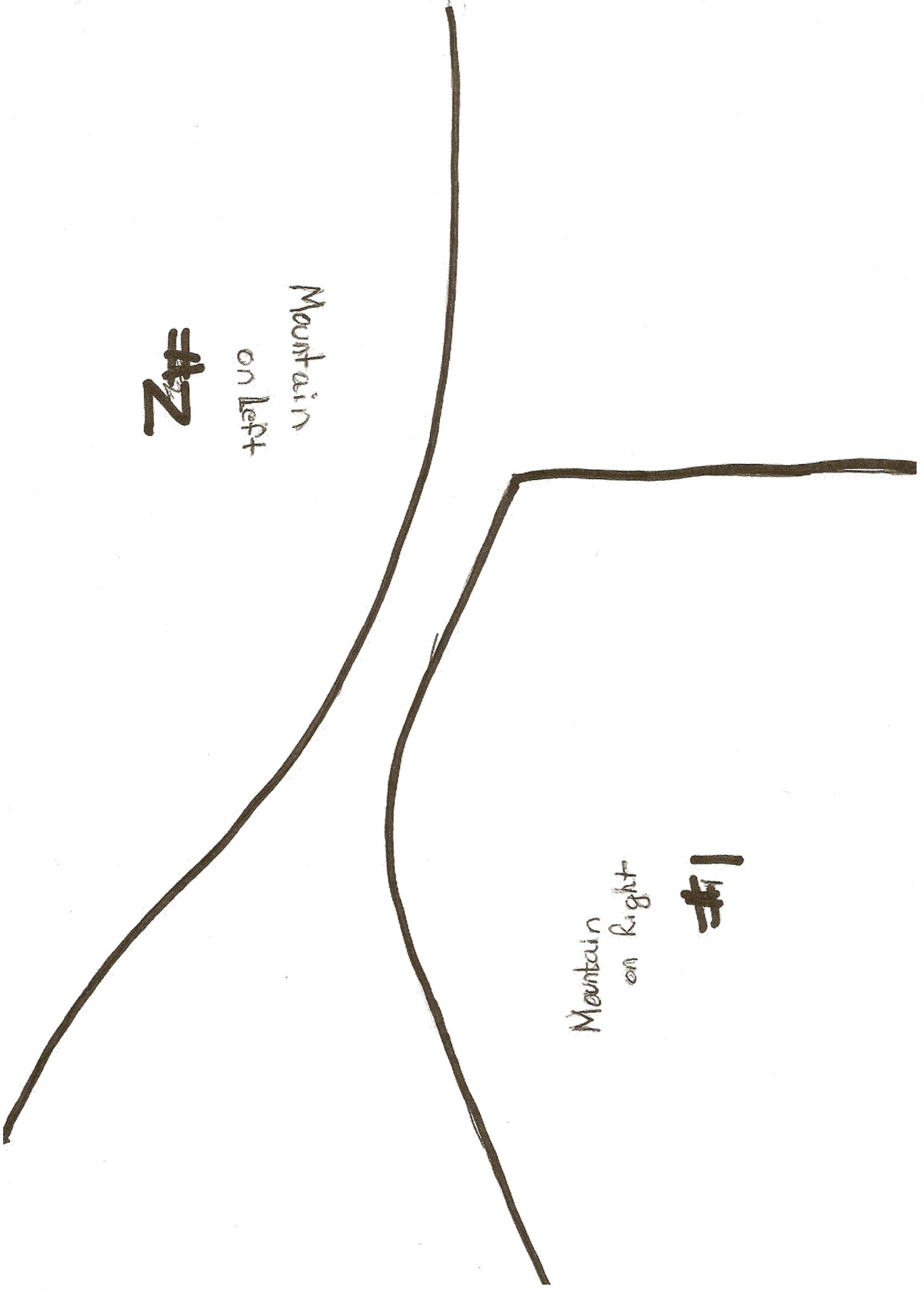
You can now appliqué you land and cabin in place.

RIVER... It goes at an angle on the bottom of #4 land.

ASPEN TREES....If you don't have fabric to cut out aspen trees you can make some. Cut tan and white fabric with scissors in very narrow strips. Please don't cut straight some curves are acceptable. Take a fabric pen in black and add your grains to the trees. Appliqué in place or glue in place. Place the aspen trees on the bottom left going across the river to the top of the block. They should be 10 ½" long.

PINE TREES....fabric greens...cut out as many as you want and place around the cabin.

DEER..... Your choice as to the amount and size.
