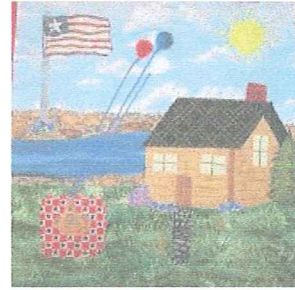


JUNE- Flag Day Celebration

Start with your foundation square of 10 ½ inches, I used sky piece of 6 ½ by 10 ½ and ground 4 inches by 10 ½ .

Fabric suggestions:

Sky

Ground

Scraps for the following:

Picnic blanket- small patterns work best -2 inch square

Brown for basket

Rock/textured brown for river bank

Blue- Water

Misc flowers for around the cabin

Red- Balloon

Blue- Balloon

White- Balloon

Yellow- Sun 3 inch circle

Cobblestone for walkway

You will also need Pearl Cotton or embroidery floss for the balloon ties and
Yellow Pearl Cotton or embroidery floss for the sun rays.

Fusible Web

I first stitched together my ground and sky pieces.

Fuse your stream across the seam length wise. You can go behind the house if you wish, or just overlap slightly.

Next Fuse your river banks down.

Next your cabin is put into place and fused.

I decorated the house next with pretty flowers fussy cut and a bush was also fussy cut or use the pattern attached.

Walk way was next to be fused.

Quilt was cut from small print. I used pinking shears to get a creative border.

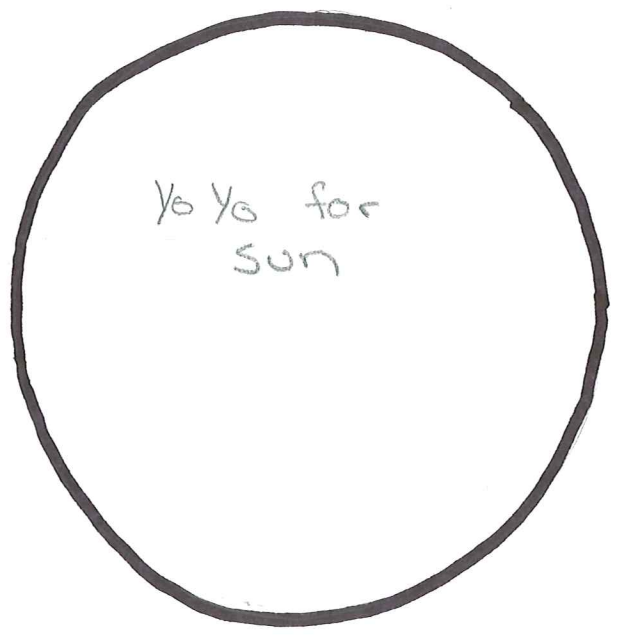
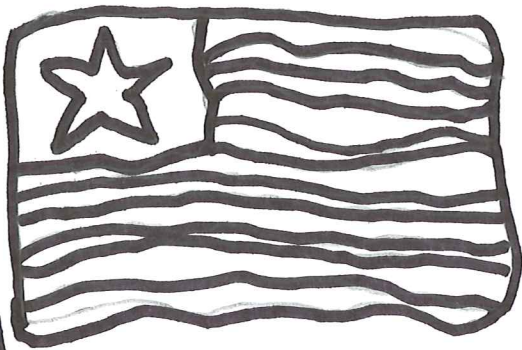
Picnic basket on top of the picnic quilt.

Fuse the flag pole first then the flag. The flag can be fussy cut as I did or you may want to applique each piece. I also placed flowers at the bottom so the pole didn't look like it was floating on the stream bank.

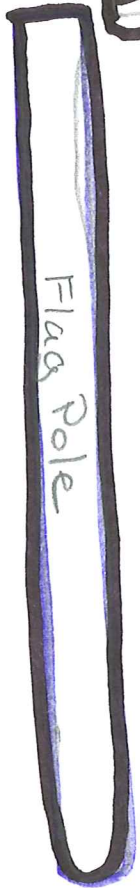
Next I fused the balloons.

The sun is a yo-yo. This give your block some dimension or you can just cut from yellow fabric. After all your fusing is done, I used the Pearl Cotton to tie my balloons down. I took a few back stitches near the balloon then attached to the basket handle.

I then put some rays on the sun with Yellow Pearl Cotton or embroidery floss.

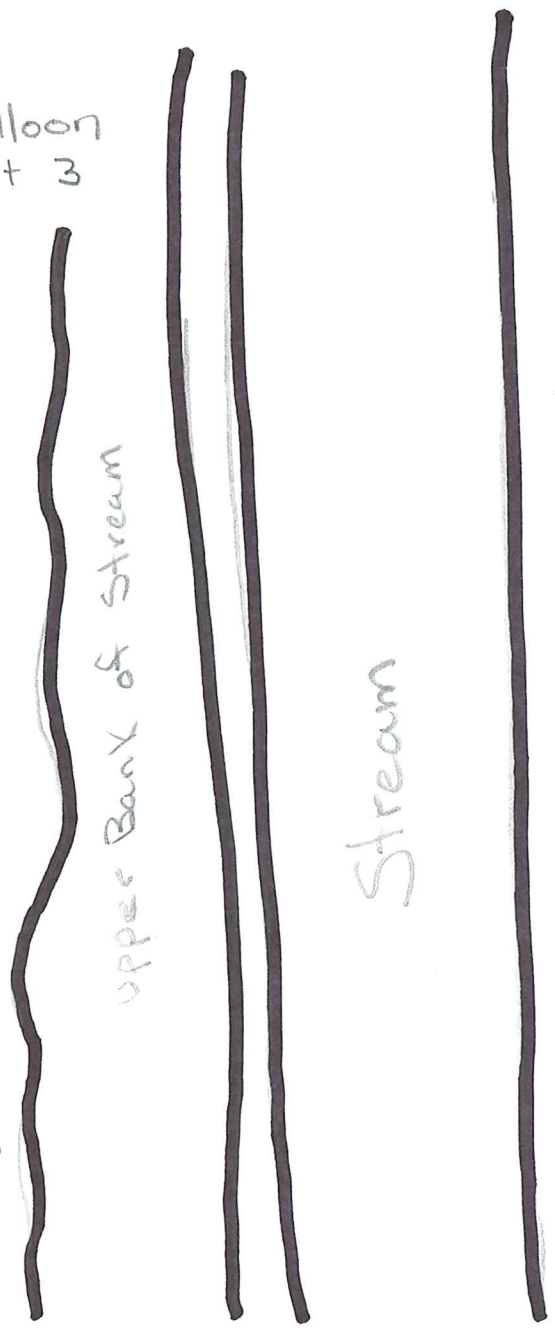
