

2008 July Warm Cabin Getaway Pattern



A WARM CABIN GETAWAY

July Block by Gail aka Krafts1 Krafts1@aol.com

10 ½" block will finish to a 10" block

Fabric suggestion:

Dark Blue fabric for sky

Green for grass

Brown for cabin, roof and fence (vary your shades)

Yellow/Gold for windows

Red brick for chimney

Stone look for walkway

Fireworks Fabric

Tree Fabric

Small Quilt Fabric (or make your own if you dare!)

Other items:

Purchased Flag Appliqué

Cording for Pole (I used gold to match the flagpole on my appliqué)

Glue stick

Fusible web or Tear away Stabilizer

Notes:

No seam allowances are included with the patterns. Add 1/4" if you do needle turn appliqué. I used a lightweight fusible for my foundation and fused my background pieces to it. I then more lightweight fusible cut into small squares to tack the fabric to the foundation and then used a small zigzag to secure appliqué pieces to the square.

Please feel free to copy the design as it's shown or just make any changes you wish. Make it a fun project and don't fret too much about it. I had fun designing the block....my only problem was that I ran out of block before I ran out of embellishment ideas!! Happy Quilting!

INSTRUCTIONS:

Use pattern pieces to cut your fabric. Place your background fabrics on top of fusible (which is bumpy side up to wrong side of fabric) and fuse according to manufacturers directions.

For fence, I slightly rounded the tops of the posts and let the bottom hang off my block slightly. When I finished fusing, I trimmed the edges off.

Arrange pattern elements on your square and fuse in place. Finish edges with small zigzag stitch.

Add your own fun touches – embellish to your hearts content.
